This has been so, whatever the location.

This has caused me great concern and anguish, yet those I have been helping say that I have helped to save their lives for the testimony.

I would therefore now like to bow out and hand all these matters over to you, Mr Hales, safe in the certainty that you will bring in the resolution that is so urgently needed

Jim and Louise Hutchinson, Doncaster

I believe that Jim and Louise Hutchinson are coming to Burgess Hill on Tuesday. I've known them for 5 years and feel that they've been bullied in Sheffield, now Doncaster. This has come from within Jim's family and I've seen his wife crushed through it.

Last week Louise was admitted to care. Both Jim and the care home asked me to speak to Louise to comfort her, which I naturally did.

I can confirm that I've personally seen the effects on the above over a 5 year period since I was introduced to the family on UBT consultancy work and followed up by initially interviewing Phil and Jim separately on their own.

It's devastated Jim's life causing him to have a full on nervous breakdown in 2012.

Jim, his wife and even those trying to help them have been subjected to much pressure. Their whole reputations have been blackened and Jim's willingness to seek psychiatric help has not lessened this.

Mark Hynd and Tim Little have witnessed the wrong side of Phil Hutchinson and Mike Hughes respectively but have been a lot wiser than me by keeping out!

A report you received in Boston on 11th October must have been inaccurate. It was never investigated by Leeds, just accepted as authoritative and final despite me telling the priests that it was untrue. Jim and Louise could witness to that.

When I sent the attached conciliatory email to Garth, Roger and Chris Stutterheim, it was rejected and I was told that if I took it any further, "it'd bring sorrow and grief on me and my family".

The fact that you accepted the report, Mr Hales, is used as justification for its accuracy.

From my side, Jim and Louise had my sympathies so I only tried to help them. Unfortunately, this has been misrepresented and the uncompromising and repeated insistence that I contravened the local rules seems to erode logical thinking and intrudes on personal boundaries.

However, the local brethren in both Doncaster and Leeds have suddenly cut me out and told me not to have any contact.
